Since joining the scheme in November 2009, 20% of our workforce are now signed up to the scheme. 74 people from our supply chain have attended the medical assessment sessions and our sub-contractors Squires and Linsco have subsequently joined the scheme.

Interesting findings...

- One member of staff was advised to go and see his GP immediately following an on-site health assessment with CBH
- A crane operator was advised to 'see' an optician as his eyesight was well below DVLA standards
- Two others were referred to a specialist for further HAV's assessment
- Thankfully, the majority of our workforce are fit and well, which is great for our business

The CBH toolbox talks were well received on our site in Nottingham, and a number of employees have been given the opportunity to resolve health problems at an early stage.
